On route to the Ceiriog Valley, we make a stop at the Plassey Leisure Park. The multi-award-winning Plassey Leisure Park is set is 247 acres of magnificent park and woodland in the beautiful Dee valley. The Plassey complex houses a thriving craft and retail centre with some 25 businesses ranging from boutiques to handmade crafts, plus a coffee shop.

Turn right in the little town of Chirk, just south of Wrexham in North Wales, and you travel up the little-known Ceiriog Valley. Described by David Lloyd George as a little bit of heaven on earth. Further up the Pass, the more outstanding the mountainous scenery becomes. Eventually, at the head of the valley, we reach the village of Llanarmon Dyffryn Ceiriog nestled beneath the Berwyn Mountains. Here we stop for our lunch at the Hand Hotel in the centre of the village. The restaurant offers farmhouse-style cooking using fresh local produce, and you can order directly from this extensive menu.

Later, we visit Moreton Park Garden Centre. The garden centre is widely regarded as one of the top centres in Europe. Take a stroll through the numerous shops in the gallery and enjoy afternoon coffee.
