The National Trust property of Speke Hall is a rare example of a Tudor Manor house with Victorian interiors. Situated in a most unusual setting, attractive gardens and woodland surround it. This beautiful building has witnessed more than 400 years of turbulent history. Uncover the hidden Tudor secrets and enjoy a bracing walk with views of the Welsh hills.

The gardens and woodlands are not extensive but there is a pleasant walk on level paths which takes in a circuit of the South Lawn, past the rose garden, along the Moat garden, around the hall and then through the stream garden onto the North Lawn.

There are woodland walks throughout the estate which are particularly recommended in the Bluebell season. You might also like to take a walk on the Bund, a raised earth embankment which commands spectacular views across the Mersey Estuary and provides a wonderful view of the woodland at the South of the Hall.

There is also a restaurant on site. Hot lunches are served between 12pm and 2pm and lighter meals are available all-day (not included).
