SOUTH EAST WIRRAL TOUR WHEATSHEAF INN, RABY



We start the day with a tour of the lanes and villages of the South East Wirral.

The tour includes the village of Port Sunlight, the homes were built by Lord Lever Hulme in 1888 for his workers in the local soap factory and other business concerns. The tour also includes a coffee stop at the Lady Lever art gallery (no entrance fee needed).

Next we visit Brombrough Poole Village, a model village built in 1853 - 1858, for the workers of the Price's patent Candle Company. Finally, we journey to Eastham Village and Eastham Ferry area.

Our lunch stop takes us to the Wheatsheaf Inn, Raby - locally known as The Thatch due to its lovely, thatched roof. Later we call at a local place of interest.
